Only registrants could vote

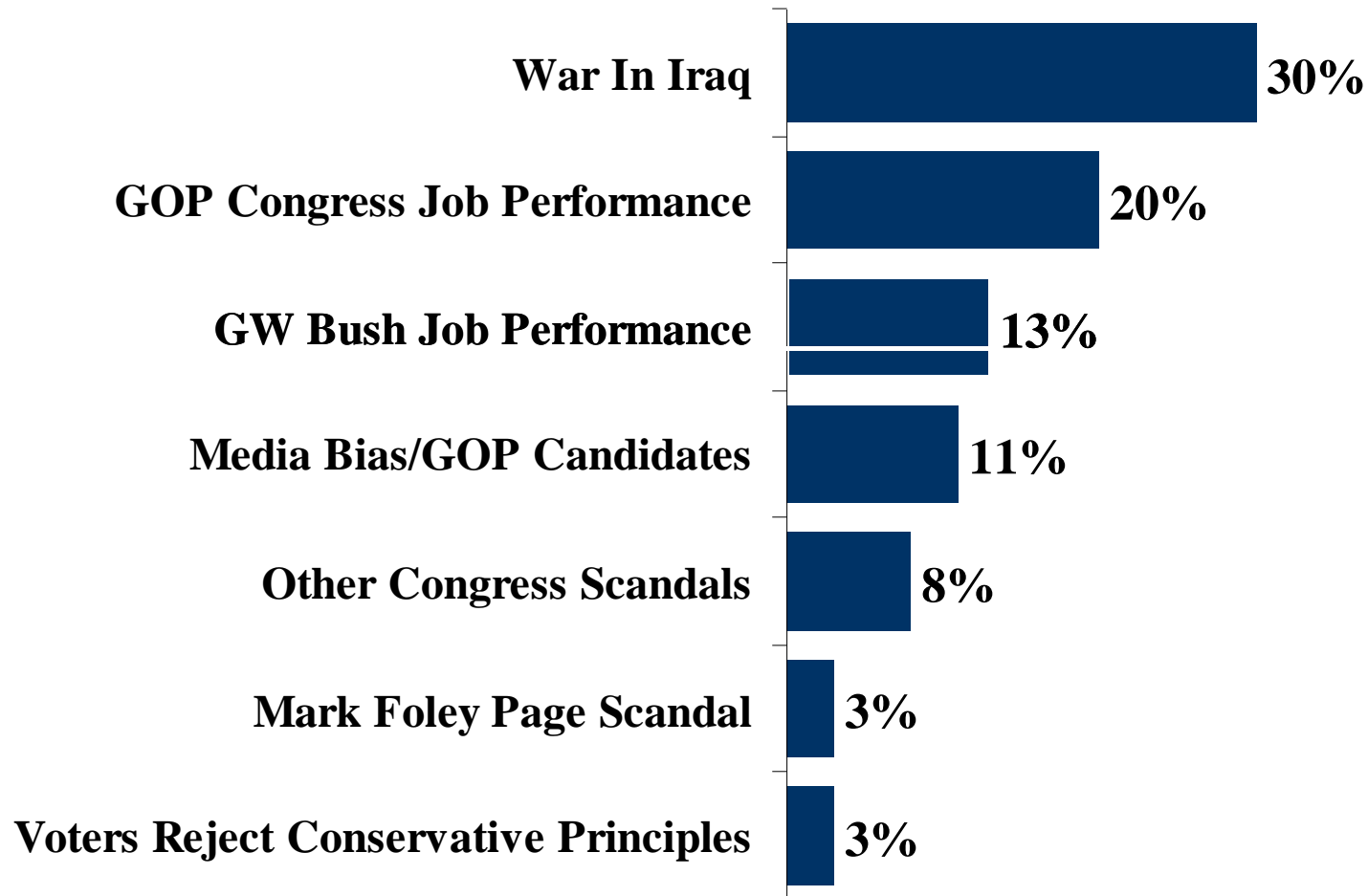
1705 ballots represents the largest straw poll in CPAC history

49 States plus DC represented in the balloting



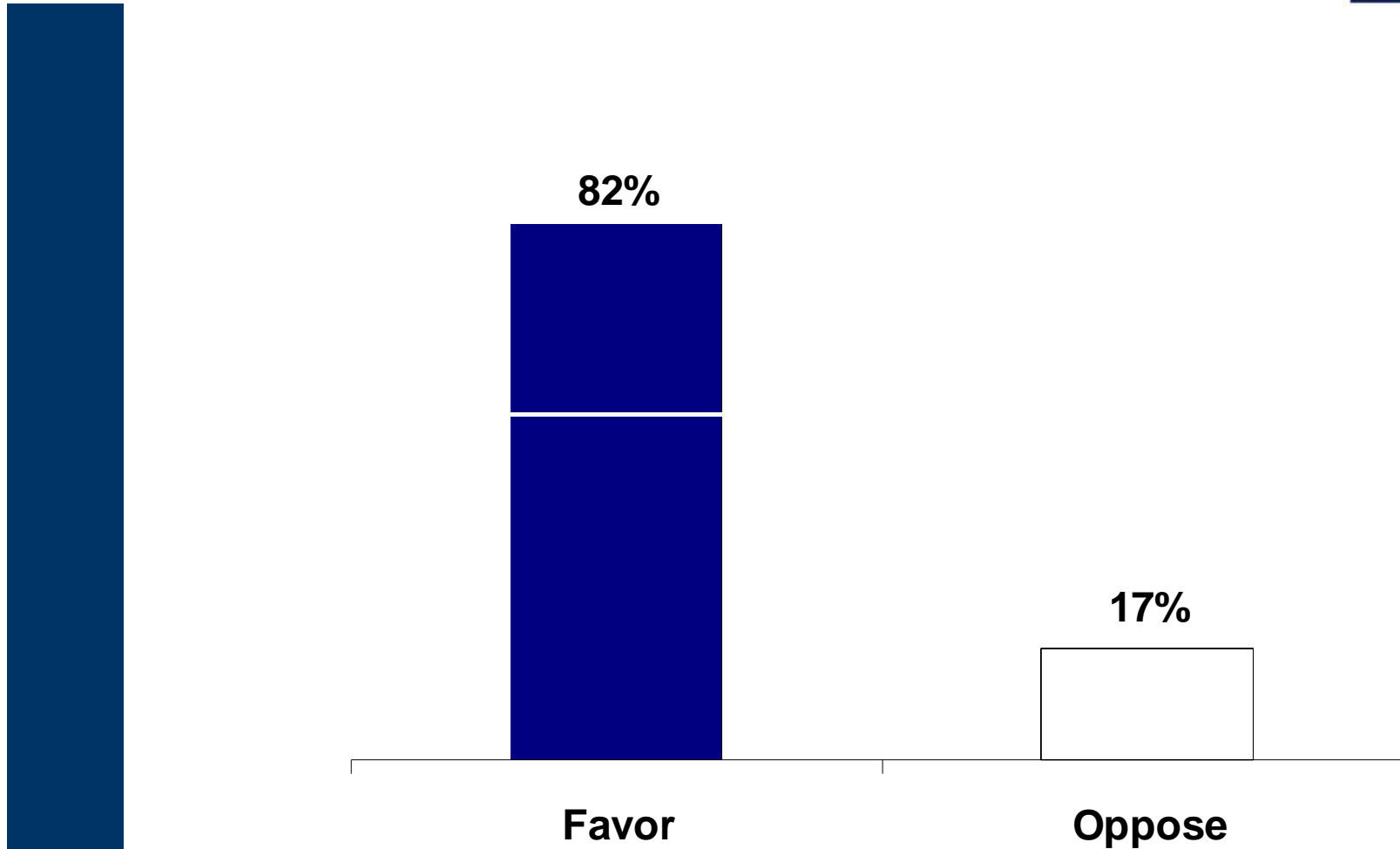
In your opinion, why did the Republicans suffer the losses they did in last November's elections? Was it because of...

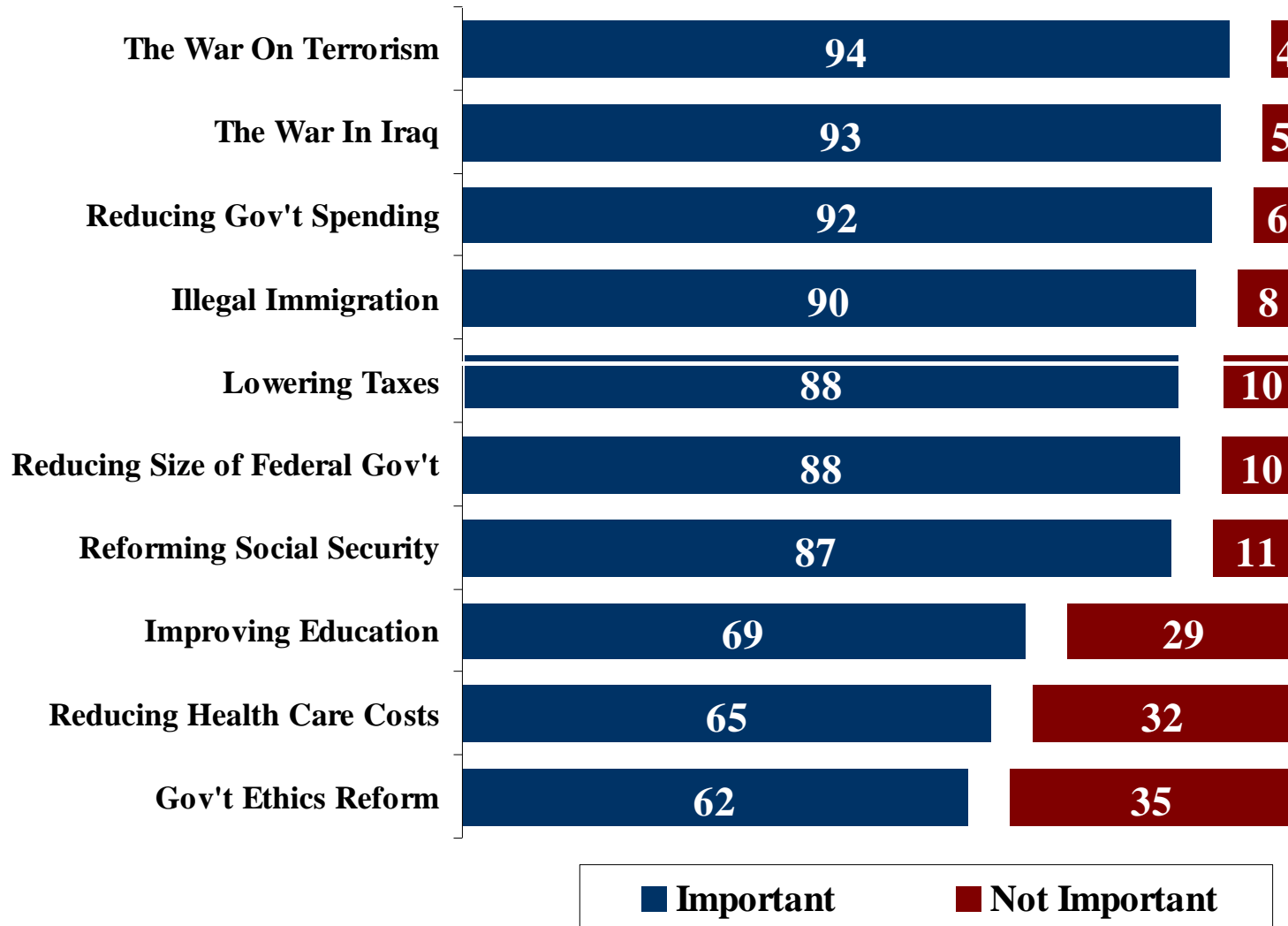

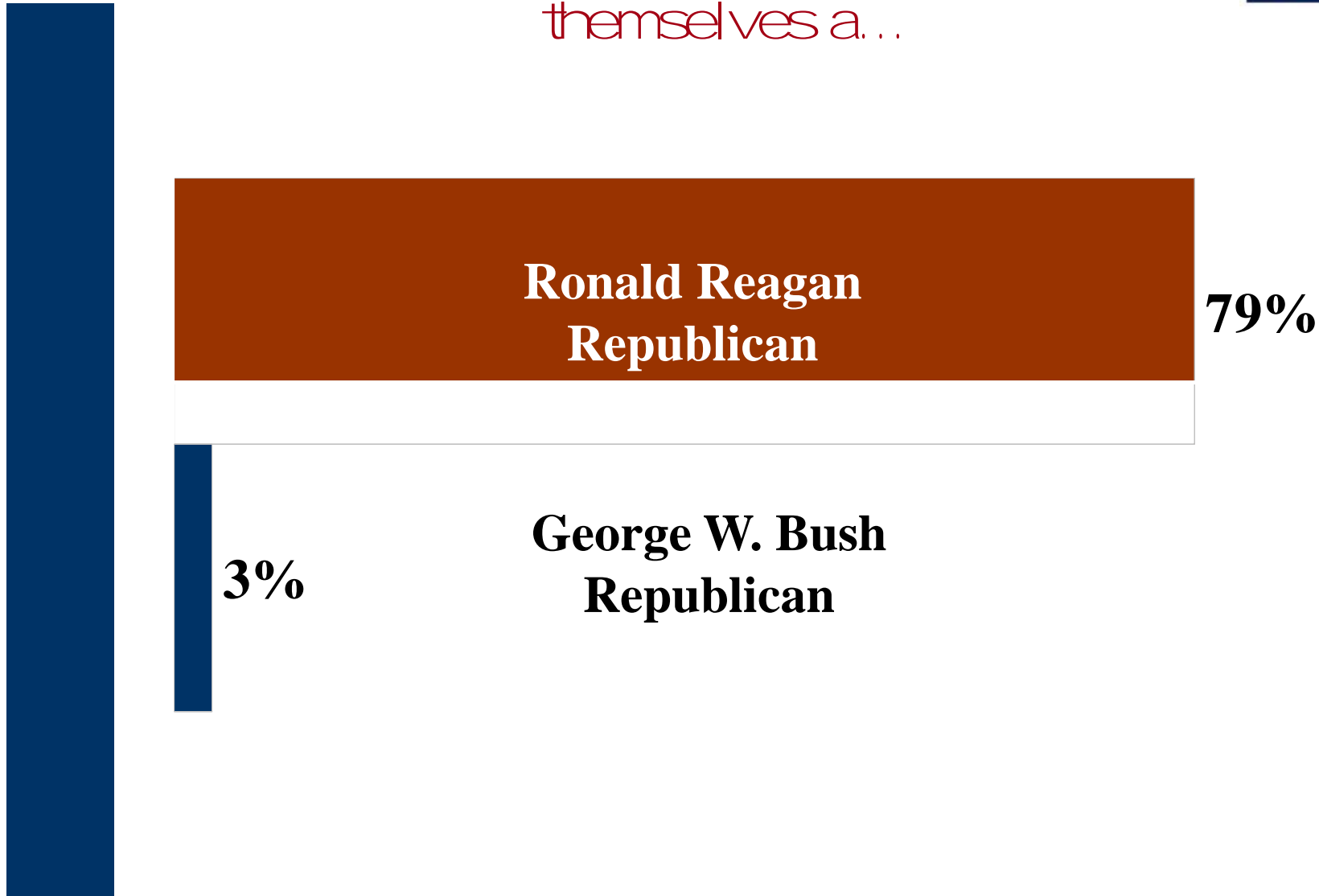
How important is it for the next Republican nominee to focus on each of the following issues?

All things being equal, would you be MOST likely to support a Republican candidate for President who called themselves a...



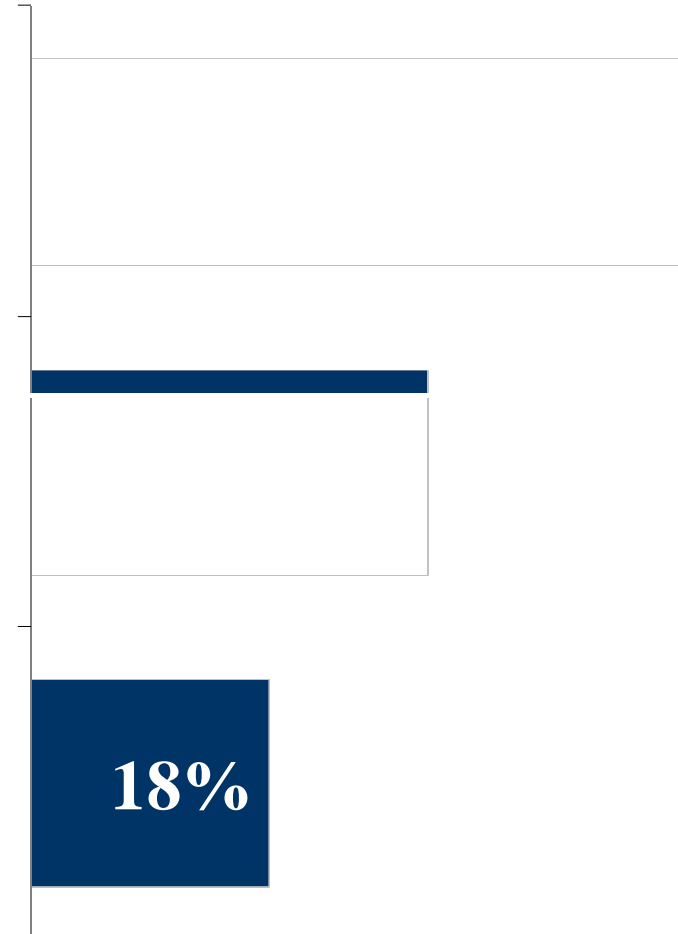

My most important goal is to promote individual freedom by reducing the size and scope of government and its intrusion into the lives of its citizens.

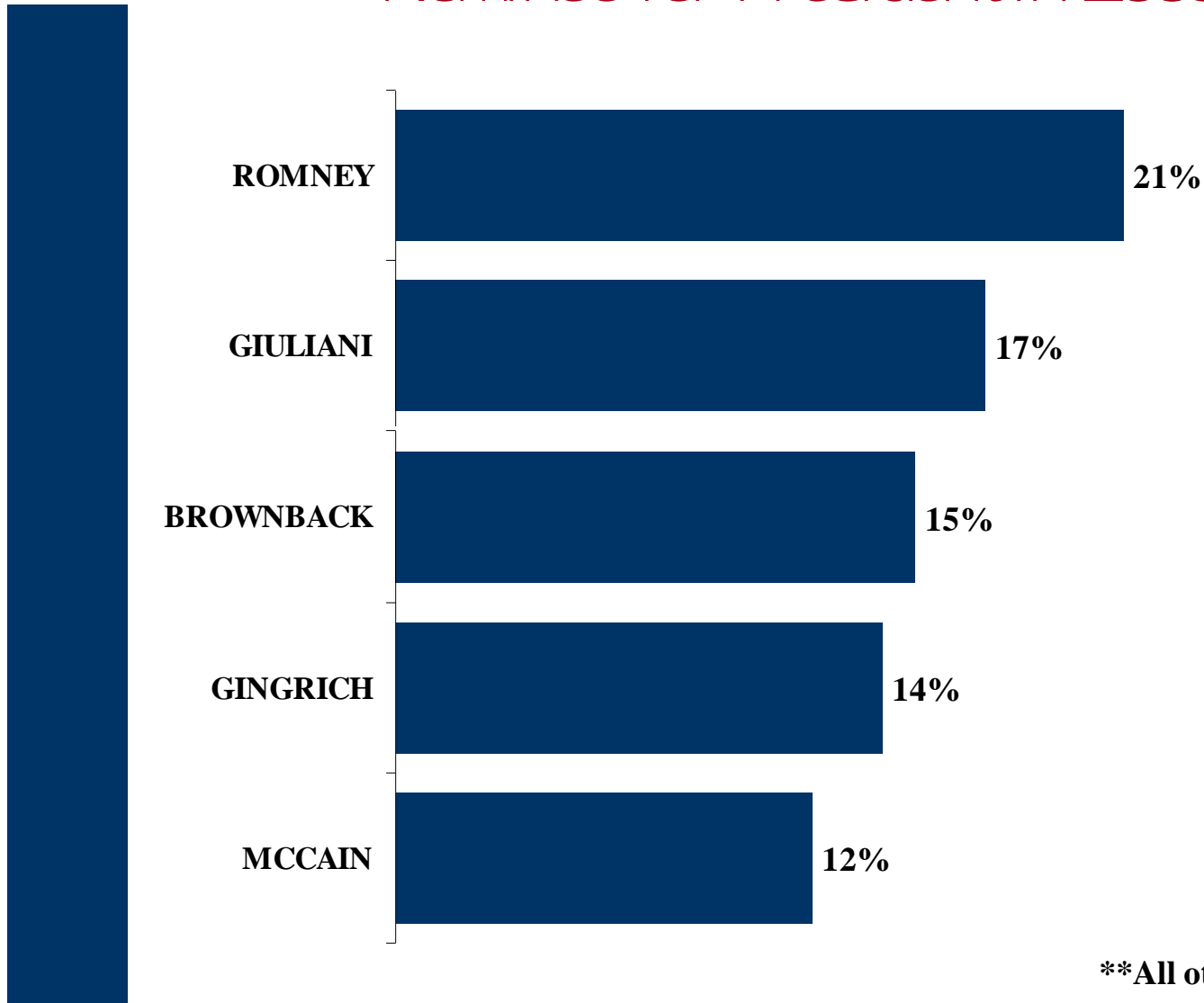
My most important goal is to promote traditional values by protecting traditional marriage and protecting the life of the unborn.

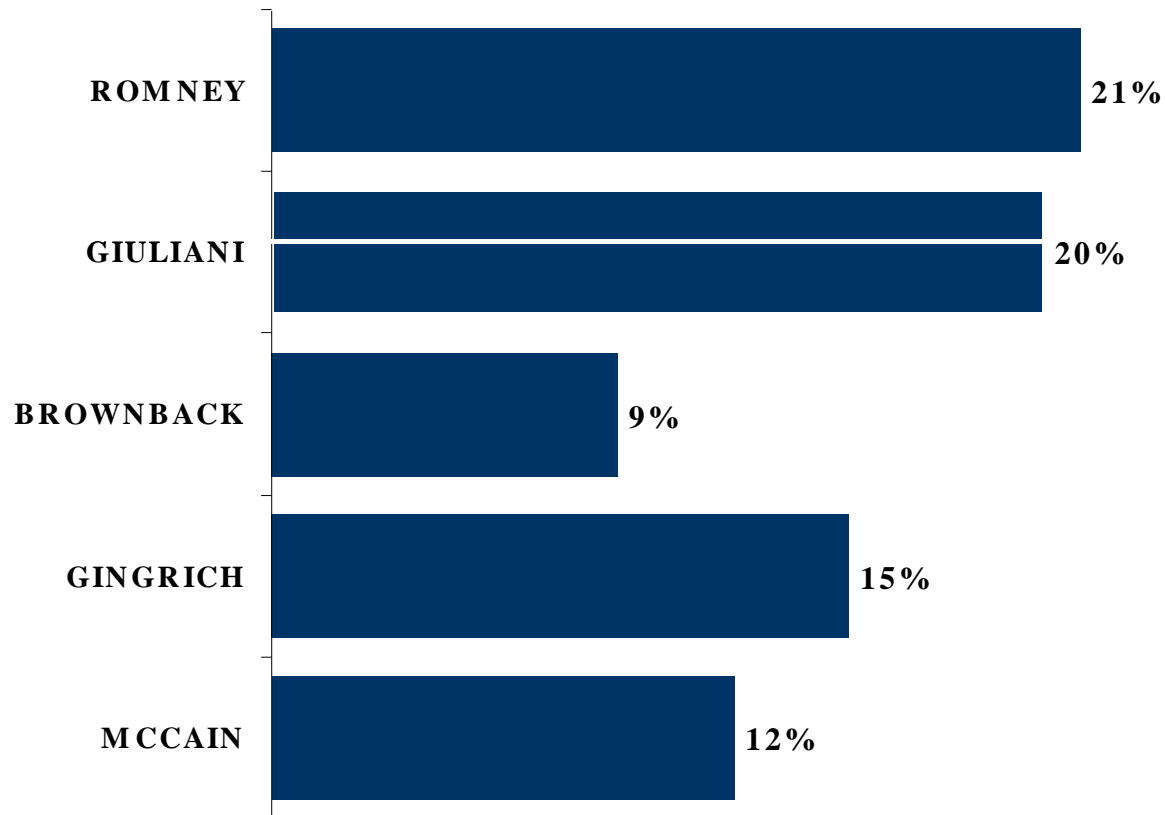

AMONG INDIVIDUAL FREEDOM AND REDUCE SIZE OF GOV'T



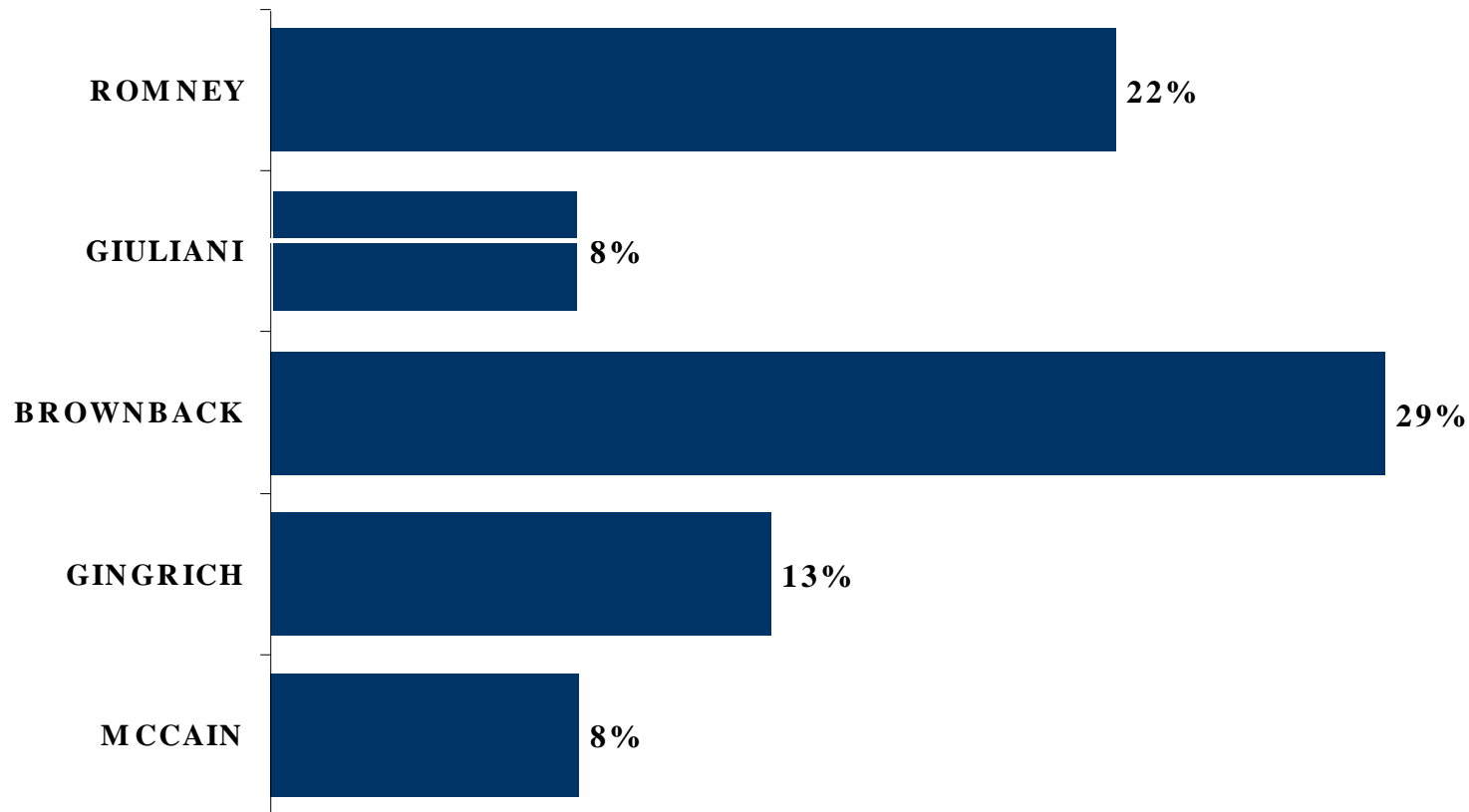

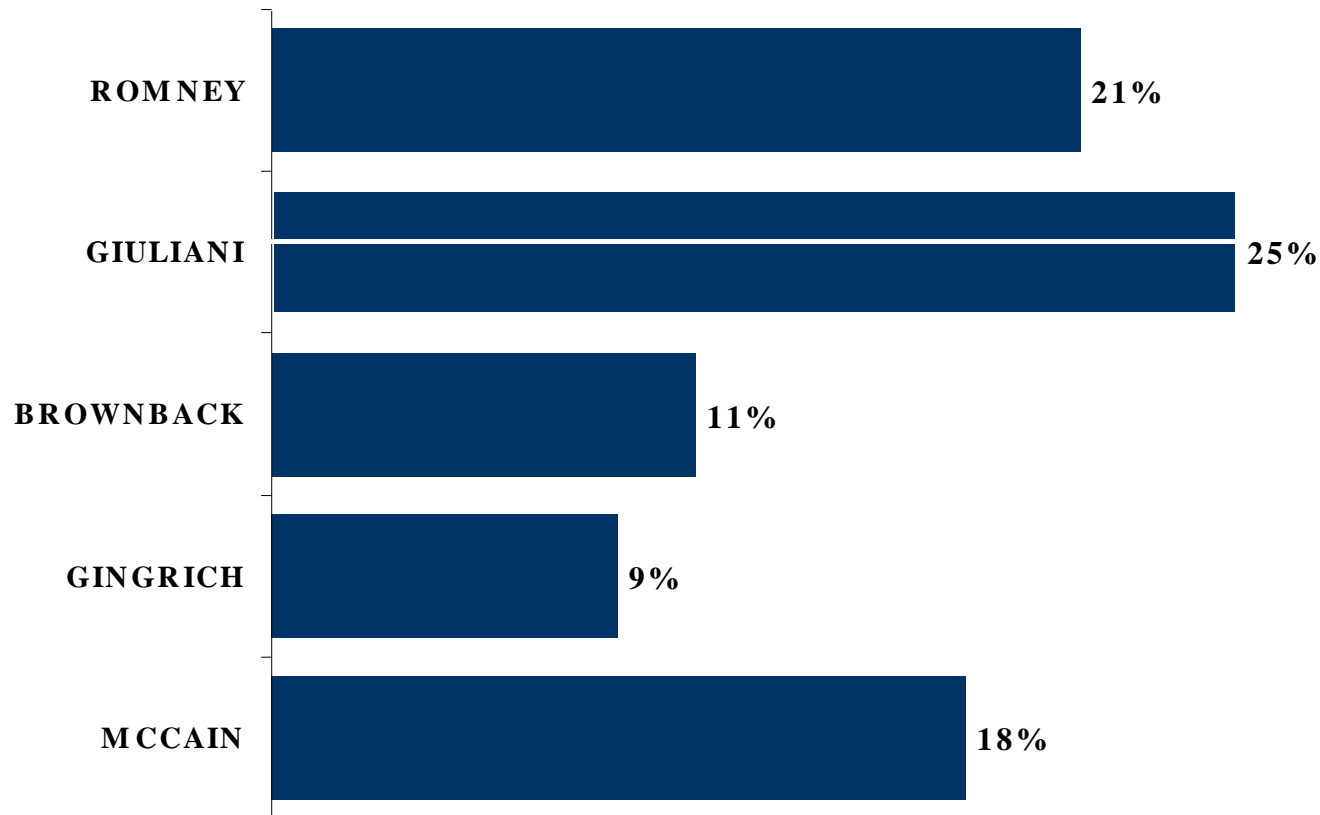

From the following list- who would be your FIRST choice to be the Republican Nominee for President in 2008?



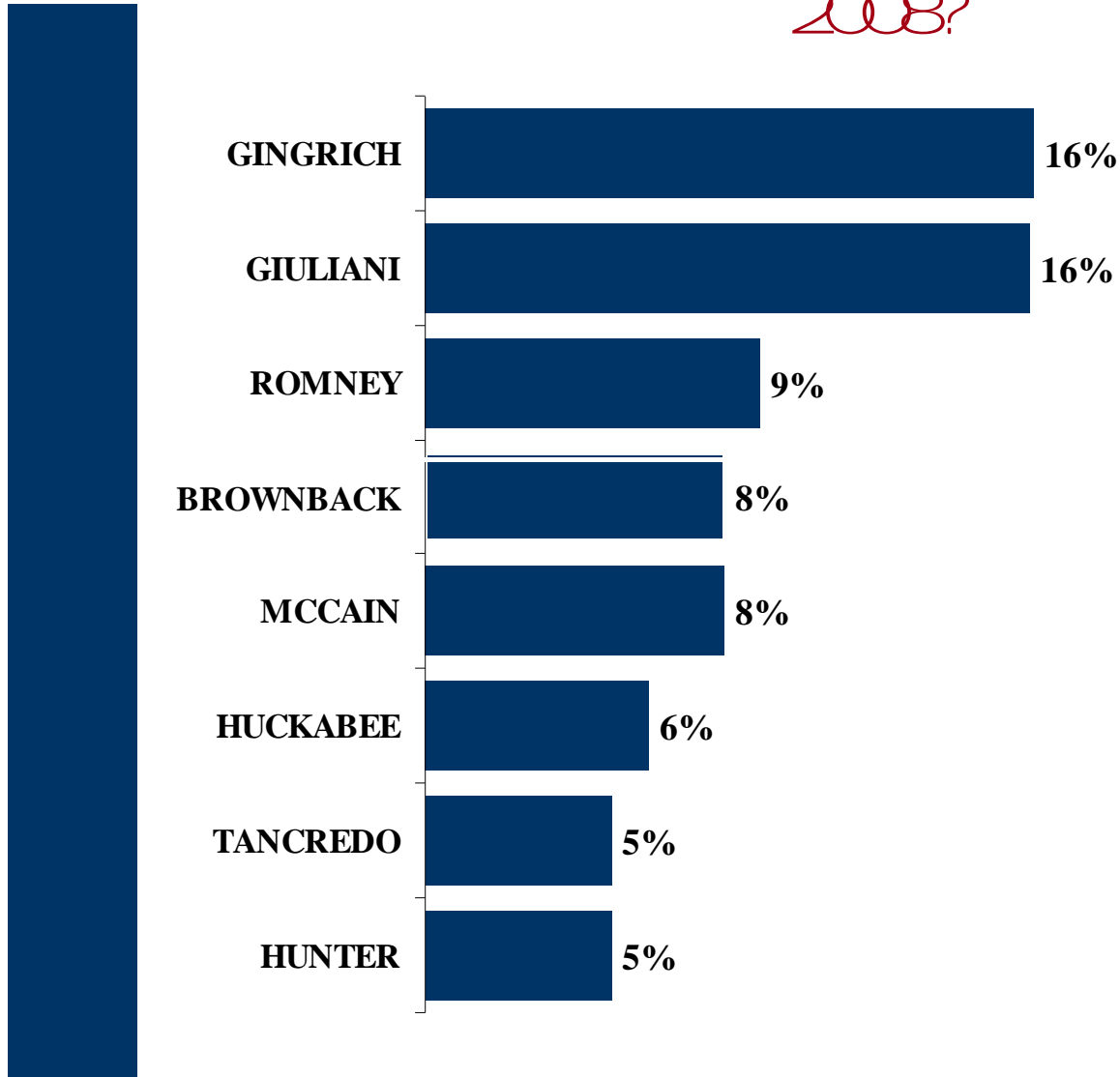
AMONG SECURE AND GUARANTEE SAFETY

Now from the same list - who would be your SECOND choice to be the Republican Nominee for President in 2008?

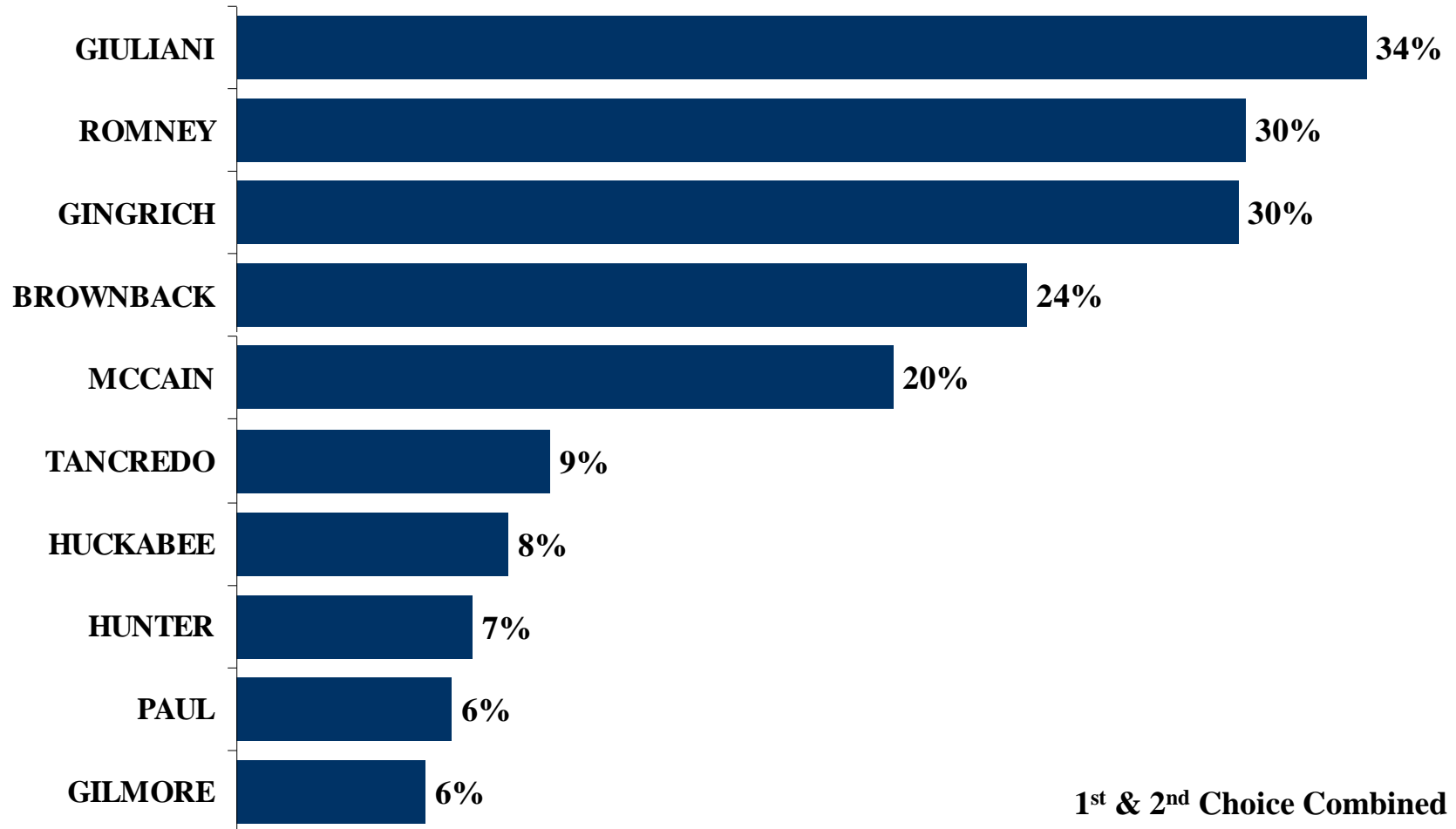

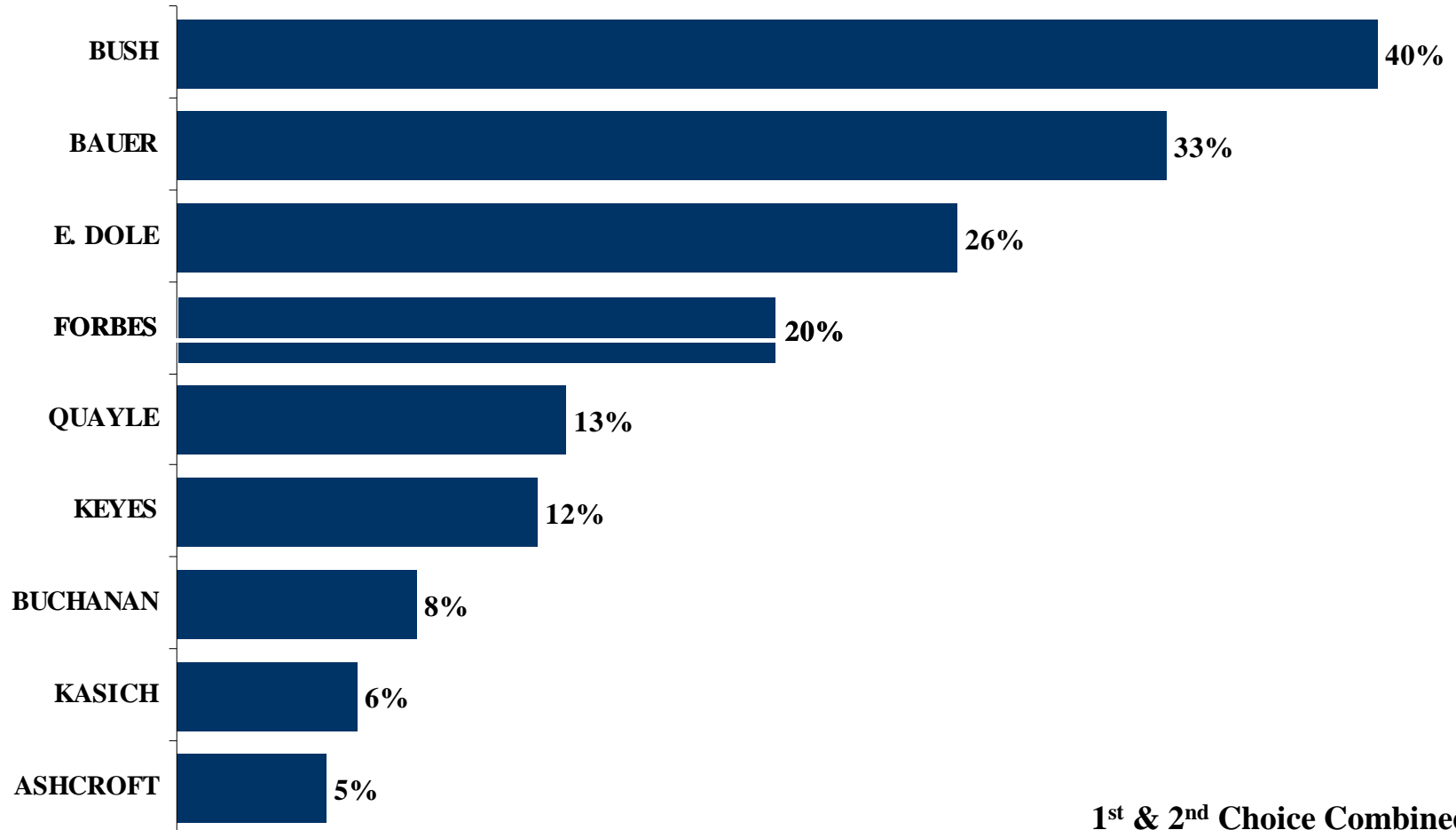

COMBO 1st and 2nd Choice – Republican Nominee for President in 2000?



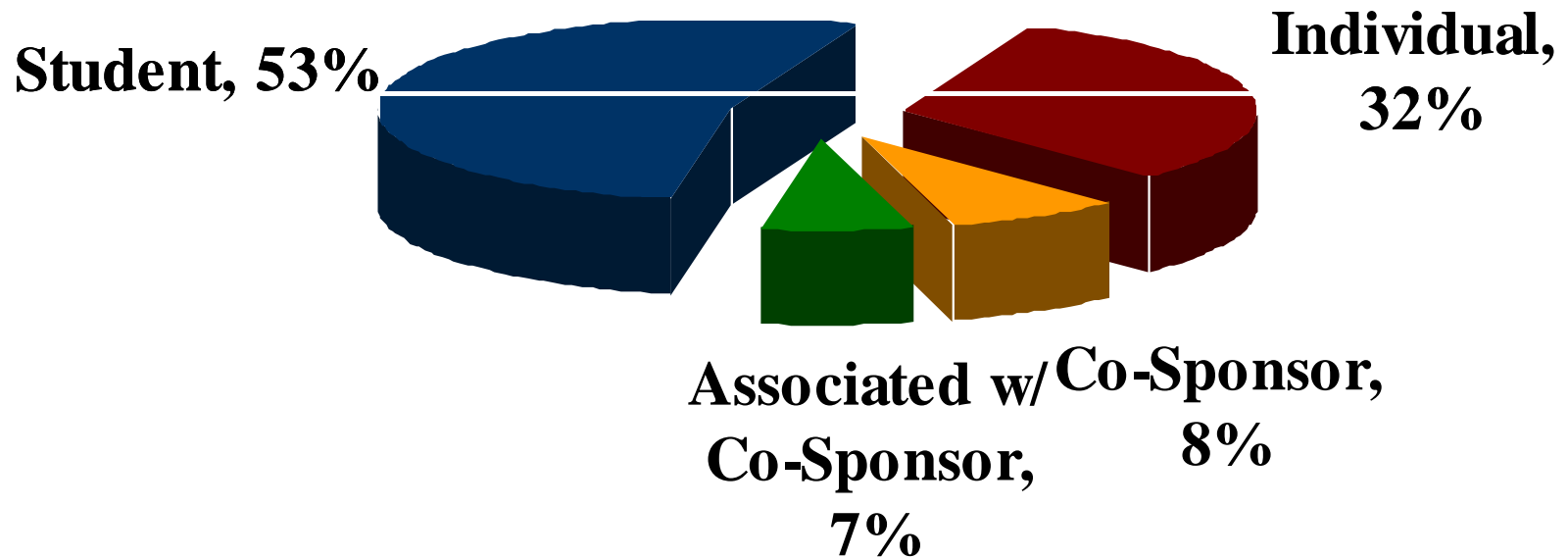

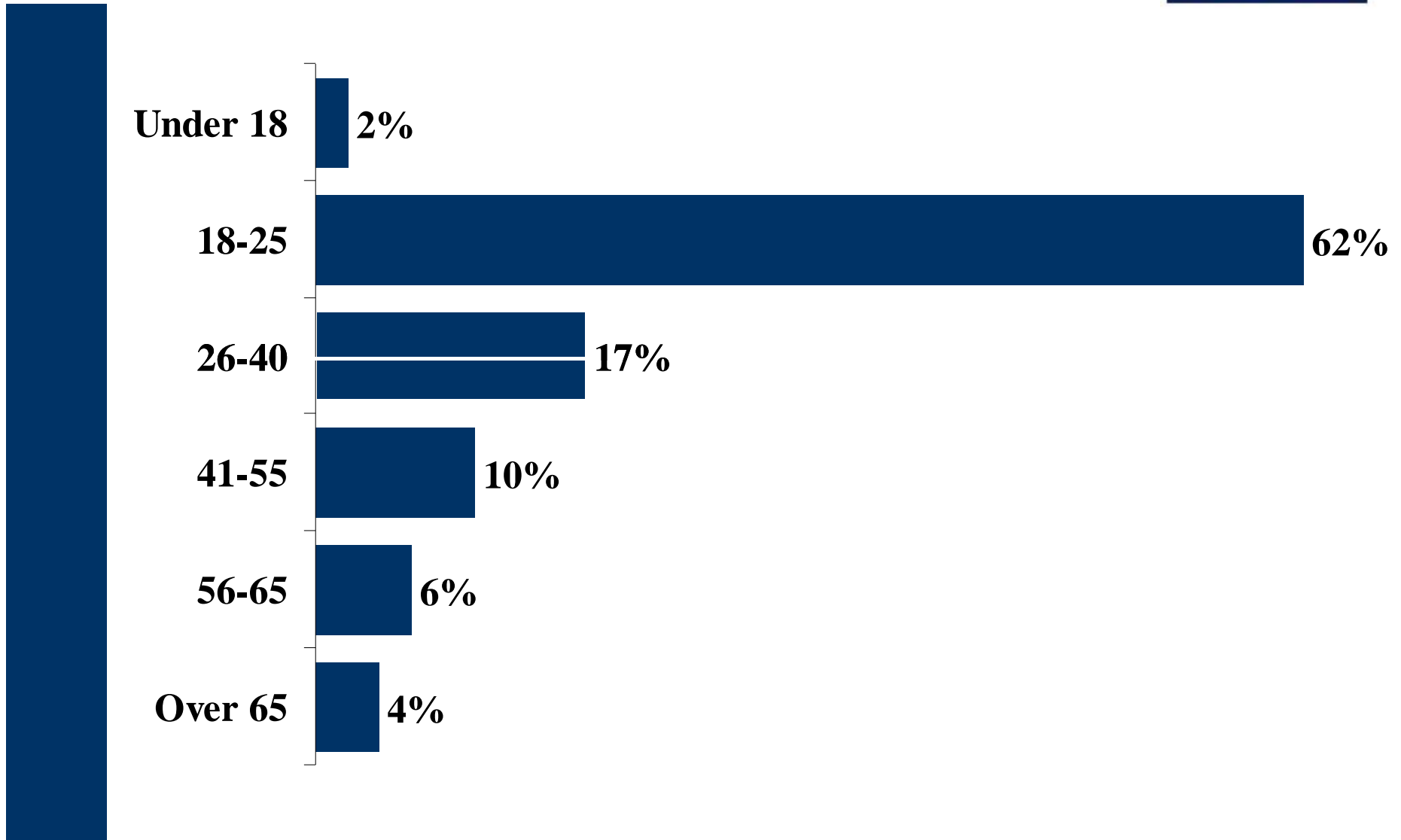

Type of Registrant

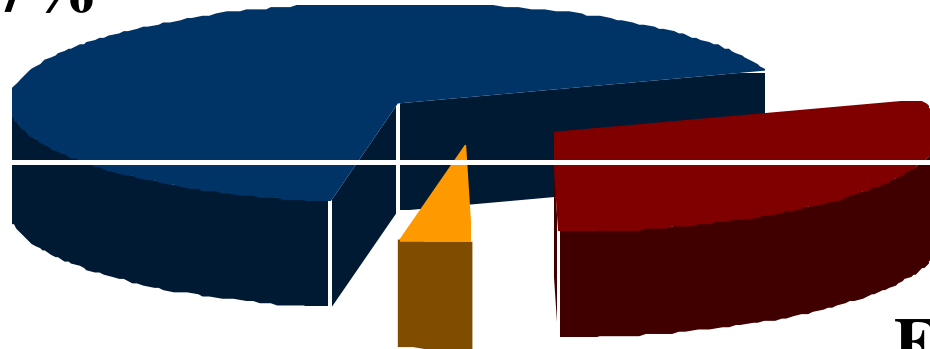
