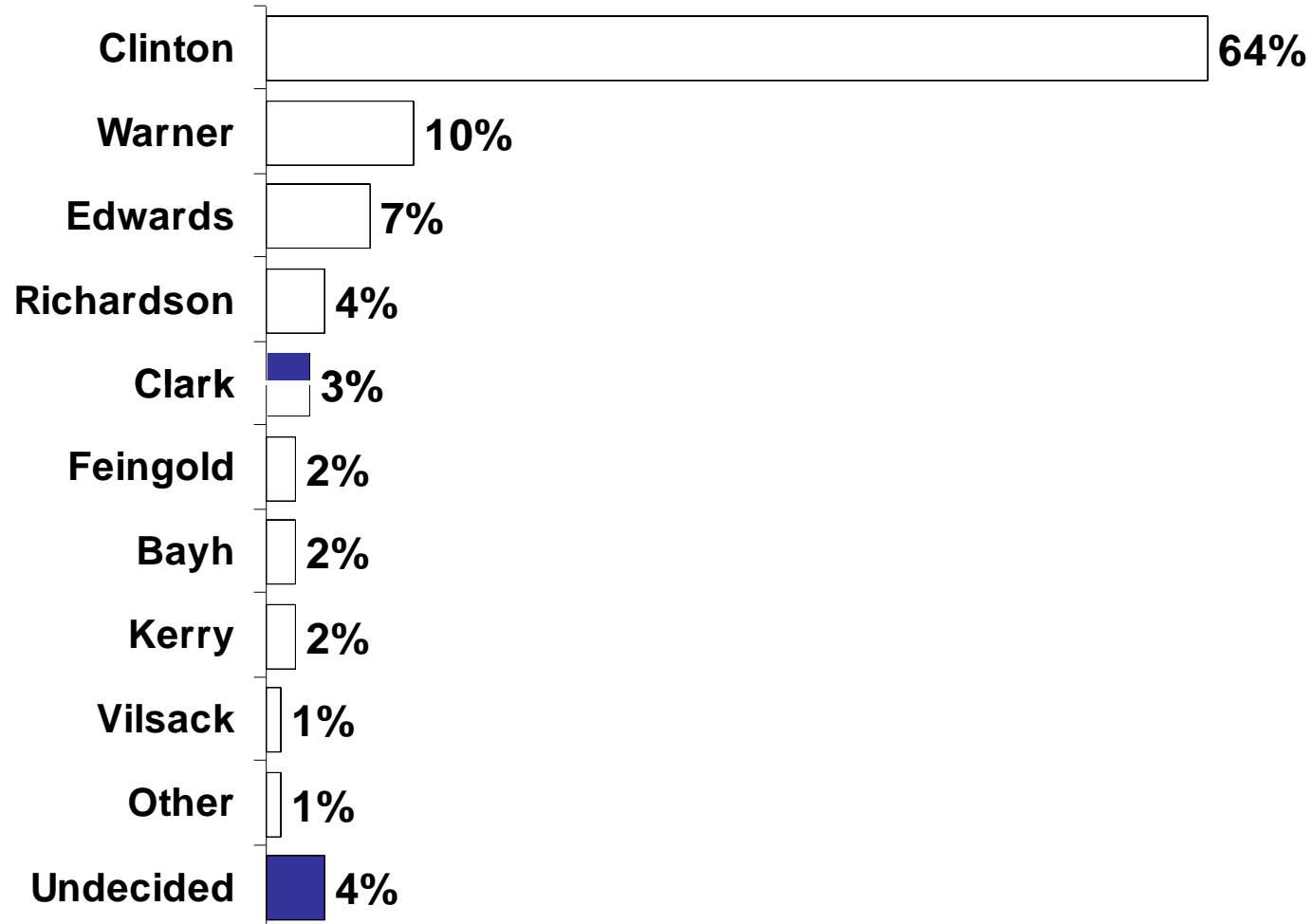

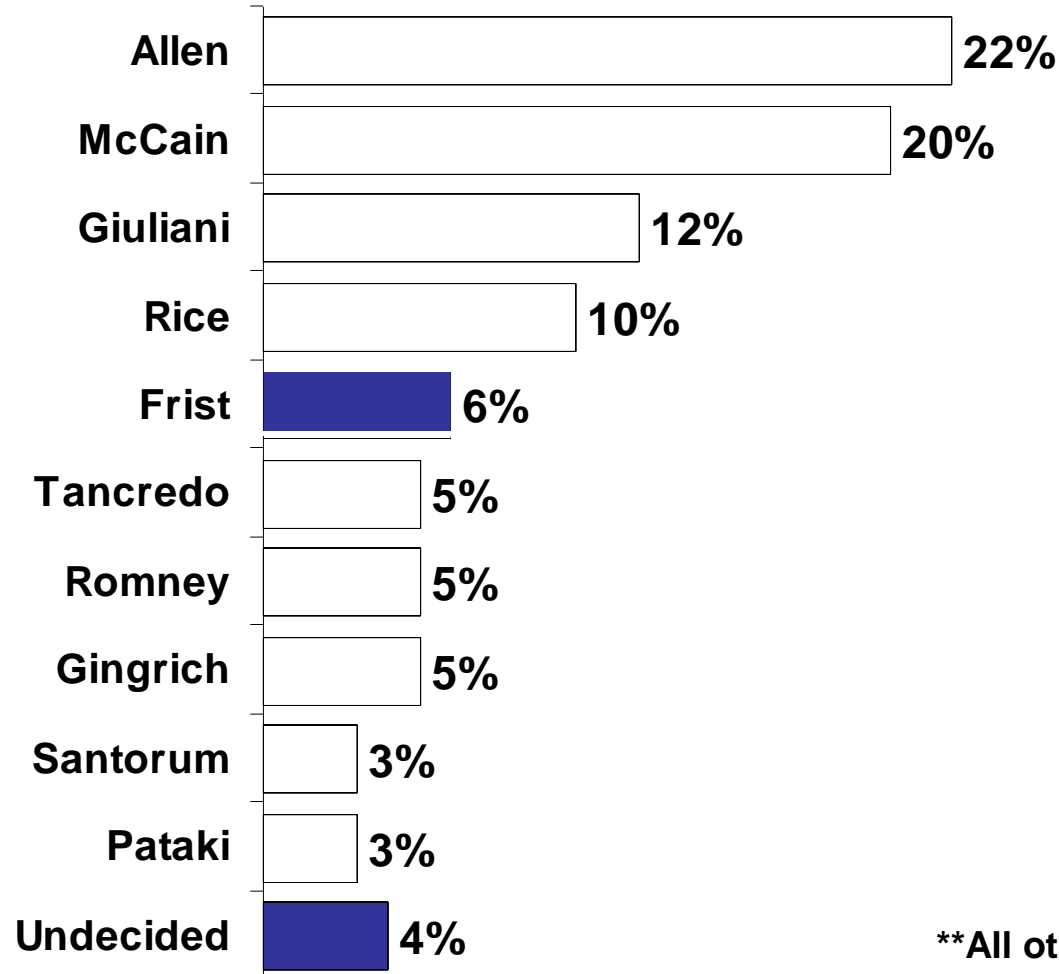


# Of the following whom do you believe DEMOCRATS will nominate for President in 2008?





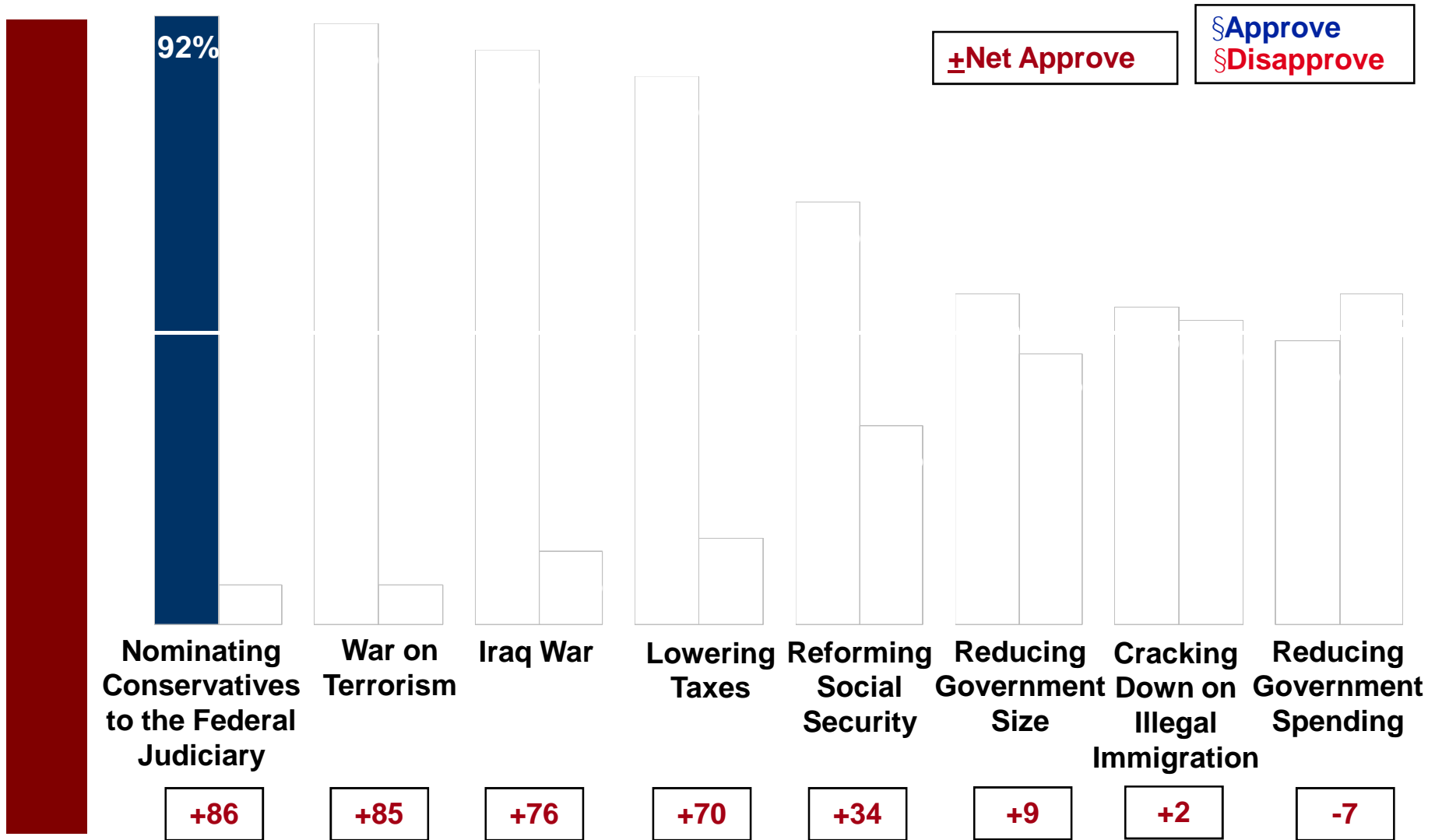
## Thinking ahead to the 2008 Presidential election, who do you think will be the next Republican nominee for President?

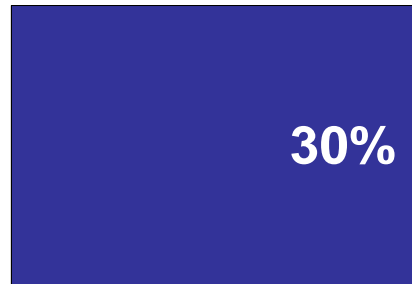

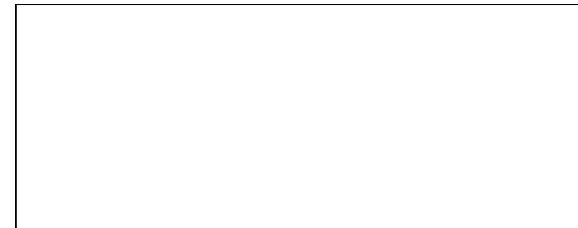

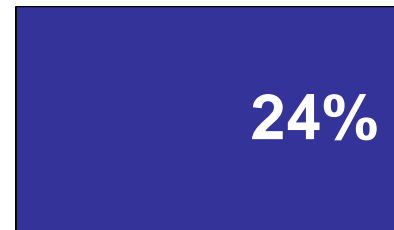
**We should be prepared to give up some freedom for increased security.**

## Which ONE of the following comes closest to your core beliefs and ideology?

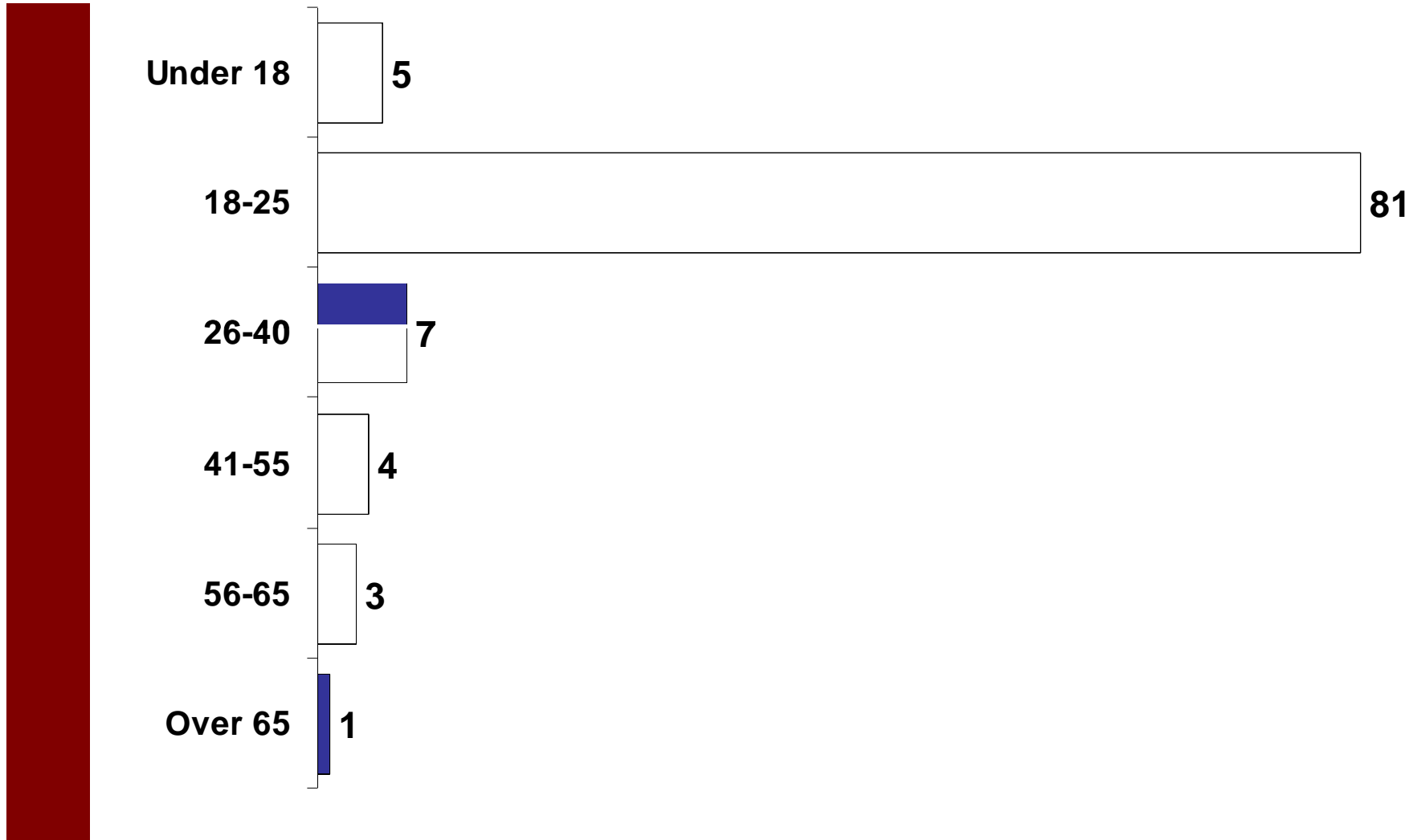
**My most important goal is to promote individual freedom by reducing the size and scope of government and its intrusion into the lives of its citizens.**

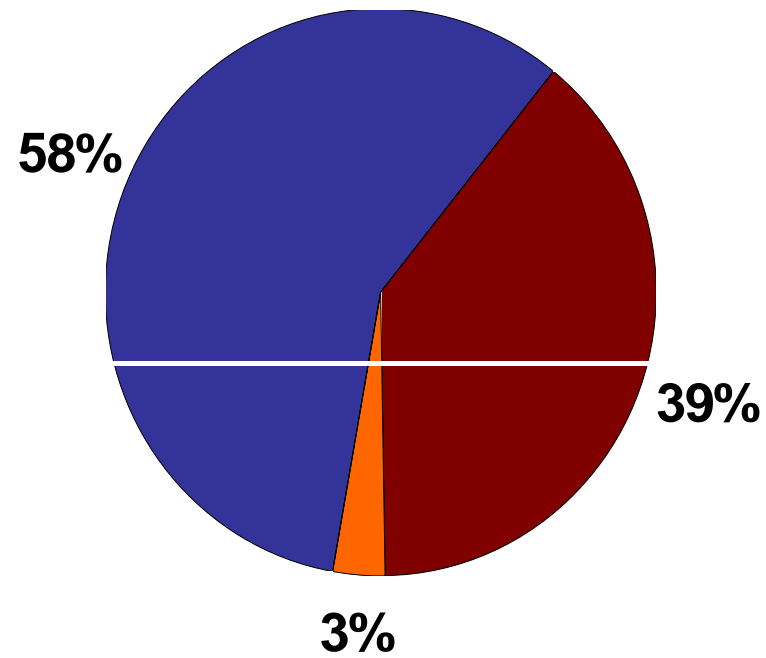
