### Clinton wins straw poll

Sen. Hillary Rodham Clinton of New York won a Democratic presidential straw poll conducted by a convention of San Diego Democratic clubs on Saturday.

Clinton received 25.4 percent of the 291 votes cast at the convention held at Liberty Station in Point Loma. Former Sen. John Edwards of North Carolina placed a close second with 21.6 percent.

Rounding out the field were Sen. Barack Obama of Illinois, 15.8 percent; Rep. Dennis Kucinich of Ohio, 13.7 percent; former Vice President Al Gore (who is not a candidate), 13.7 percent, and New Mexico Gov. Bill Richardson, 8.9 percent.
